In the event of discontinuation of the course due to any reason, the candidate has to –

- ★ Write a requisition application for the same duly countersigned by the Parent / Guardian.
- ★ Pay all the dues i.e Entire course fees for 3 Years, Library Books to be returned to the college for obtaining the transfer certificate, conduct certificate and other relevant documents.

RULES GOVERNING ADMISSION

1. Applications from eligible candidates should be made in the prescribed form only.
2. Separate applications must be submitted for each course/Shift. The applicants must read the instructions carefully and make sure that they are eligible for the course they are applying for as per the University norms.
3. Application form will be issued in the name of the candidate seeking admission. It is not transferable.
4. Candidates and their parents shall be solely responsible for the declaration made in the application form. If, at any time, it is found that the particulars given are incorrect / inaccurate / incomplete, the admission will be forfeited.
5. Candidates must fill in the applications legibly in their own handwriting.
6. Filled in application should be submitted at the college office immediately after publication of the results of the qualifying examination.
7. Applicants from other states / other boards, where the results are announced late, can send their filled forms within the stipulated date except the result column and they should submit their marks within a week after the publication of the result.
8. Each application form has a serial number which should be quoted as a reference.

10. Selected candidates from other States have to get the Migration Certificate & Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras, and submit to the office.
11. The parent or guardian must accompany the candidate at the time of interview and admission.
12. Selected candidates are advised to keep extra xerox copies of their certificates as the originals will be retained at the college office which will be returned to the candidate only on the completion of the course.
13. If the candidate admitted is absent to the college for five or more days continuously, her name will be removed from the rolls.
14. Candidates proficient in sports at the State or National level and other curricular activities will be given preference in admission.
