Sri Kanyaka Parameswari Devasthanam and Charities, founded two hundred and ninety four years ago by the Arya Vysya Community, render yeomen service to the community. They have four schools, two each for girls and boys in Chennai. They have two hostels, one for students from Std VII onwards, providing free food and accommodation and the other for two hundred students taking up professional courses. This organisation has also undertaken the feeding of 100 students, poor and infirm, throughout the year. The Charities has also two Kalyana Mandapams, a cremation ground and a ceremonial garden.

The Management Committee of the S.K.P.D. & Charities have founded the Sri Kanyaka Parameswari Art & Science College for Women to promote women's education in Chennai. Our College offers nine UG Courses & four PG Courses namely, B.A. (Sociology), B.Sc (Maths), B.Sc (Psychology), B.Sc (Interior Design & Decor), B.Sc (CS), B.C.A, B.Com, B.Com (CS), B.B.A, M.A (H.R.M.), M.Sc (I.T.), M.Com. & M.Sc. (ID & D.).

Initially the college functioned in the first floor of K.T.C.T. Girls Higher Secondary School at No.5, Narayana Mudali Street, Chennai -79 and in the year 2000 it was shifted to its present premises No.1, Audiappa Street, Chennai - 1. This area earlier known as Kotwal Chavadi is owned by the S.K.P.D. & Charities. The Management Committee has constructed the necessary classrooms, library, laboratories and provided other infrastructure for the growing needs of the college.

The aim and objective of the Charities is to give quality education, excellent coaching in curricular, extra-curricular and co-curricular activities to girls, so as to infuse self-confidence and courage in the minds of young girls who are the future makers of our country. To free women from bondage, education could be used as a tool. Empowerment can only be corollary to education. The courses offered to young girls in this institution are far from the conventional ones. They not only give women the label of being educated, but also equip them to compete in the modern job oriented competitive world.

ELIGIBILITY : UG COURSES
A pass in Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary or equivalent examination recognised by the University of Madras.
Applicants for B.Com., should have taken Commerce & Mathematics in the Higher Secondary or other qualifying examinations.
Applicants for B.Com. (Corporate Secretaryship) should have Accounts and Commerce subjects in the qualifying examinations.
Applicants for BBA should have Accounts & Commerce / Maths subjects in the Qualifying Examinations.
Applicants for B.Sc., Computer Science should have studied Mathematics as compulsory subject and for B.C.A. should have studied either Mathematics as one of the paper or Business Mathematics with Accountancy.
Applicants for B.Sc. Mathematics should have studied Mathematics in the qualifying examinations.
Applicants who have passed plus two or equivalent examination are eligible to opt for B.A. (Sociology), B.Sc. (Psychology). and B.Sc. (Interior Design & Decor).

ELIGIBILITY : PG COURSES :
M.Com. : A Candidate who has passed the B.Com., B.Com. (Corporate Secretaryship), B.B.A., B.Com (Bank Management), B.A.(Co-op), B.A. (Indus.Org), and B.Sc.(Maths), B.Sc.(Computer Science) or B.C.A. with any two core/main papers offered at the B.Com. is eligible.
M.A.(HRM) : A Pass in Bachelor's Degree in the University of Madras or any other University in any discipline.
M.Sc. (IT) : Any Bachelor's Degree having studied Maths/Statistics/Business Maths/Business Statistics/ Mathematical Physics as Main (or) Allied Subject.
M.Sc. (ID & D) : Any Bachelor's Degree in Interior Design & Decor, B.Sc. Home Science and other Department UG Students who have undergone Diploma Course in related to Architecture, Studio and Auto Cad.

- Prayer : The tone of the College is set by the prayer which commences at 8.30 a.m. on all the working days. Attendance for prayer is compulsory.

RULES GOVERNING ADMISSION

1. Applications from eligible candidates made in the prescribed forms only are considered.
2. Separate applications must be submitted for each course. The applicants must read the instructions carefully and make sure that they are eligible for the course they are applying for as per University requirements.
3. Application form will be issued in the name of the candidate seeking admission. It is not transferable.
4. Candidates and their parents shall be solely responsible for the declaration made in the application form. If, at any time, it is found that the particulars given are incorrect or inaccurate or incomplete, the admission will be forfeited.
5. Candidates must fill in the applications legibly in their own handwriting.

6. Completed applications should be submitted at the college office immediately after the publication of the results of the qualifying examination conducted in Tamil Nadu. Applicants from other states, where the results have not been announced, can still send their forms filled except the result column and they should submit their marks within the reasonable time.
7. Late or incomplete applications and those giving false information will be rejected.
8. Each application form has a serial number which should be quoted as a reference.
9. Selected candidates have to produce Original +2 Mark Statement with 3 Xerox Copy, X Standard Mark Statement Xerox Copy, Original Transfer & Conduct Certificates, 3 Xerox Copies of Latest Community Certificate, Certificate of Medical Fitness, Xerox Copy of Extra Curricular Activities Certificate, 5 Self-Addressed Envelopes and 3 Passport Size Photos.
10. Selected candidates from other States have to furnish Migration Certificate & Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras.
11. The parent or guardian must accompany the candidate at the time of interview.
12. Selected candidates are advised to keep copies of certificates required, as the originals will be returned only at the end of the course.
13. If a candidate admitted to a course abstains from classes for five or more days continuously, her name will be struck off from the rolls.
14. Candidates proficient in sports at the State or National level and other curricular activities will be given preference in admission.

INFORMATION TO PARENTS

The college authorities have, as their goals, high standards of academic efficiency and discipline. **Regular attendance at classes, laboratory work and tests is a must.** Tests are held periodically and the progress of the students is carefully monitored. Parents must co-operate with the college authorities in enforcing rules of academic, conduct and discipline and must assure the authorities that they will accept responsibility for the proper behaviour of their wards. Failure to respond to our communications will be deemed non-co-operation by parents and disciplinary action will be taken by the Principal.
